Put on your ugly Christmas sweaters and cheer on the parade from the sidelines.



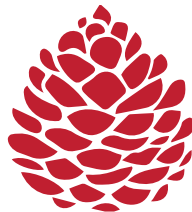
Tree Trimming

Attend school and church bazaars to support your local community.



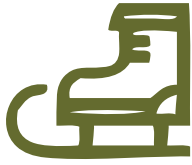
Share Yourself

Go skating, skiing or tobogganing.



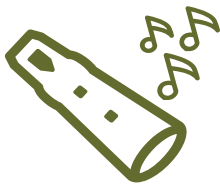
Movie Night

Write a letter to Santa. Tell him three nice things that you did today and one gift that you would like for Christmas.



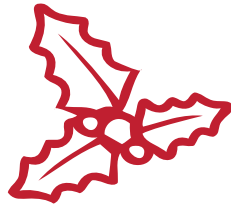
Give to Others

Mom and Dad enjoy a romantic night by the Christmas tree when all the kids are sleeping. Share a glass of wine and cheese or just a cup of tea.

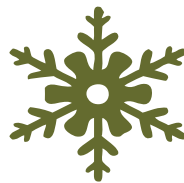


Tree Camp Out
